Lorna Kidjo is a bilingual Canadian filmmaker and actor, born in Belgium with Beninese heritage. Her directorial debut, the dark comedy-horror short *Fester*, premiered at the Fantasia International Film Festival and later broadcast on CINÉ+ across Europe. Her second short film, *Oversight*, won Best Actress at the Reelworld Film Festival and is available on CBC Gem as part of the *Canadian Reflections* program. She has written for youth television (TFO), worked as a script editor for ICI TOU.TV, and is currently developing two feature films supported by the Canada Council for the Arts. She is the founder of **Soirée Films Inc.** (formerly Stellar Collision Inc.), where she develops and produces women-led stories.
